<b>Class 1/1A*</b> Junior Winter Dressage <b>Preliminary Section (Qualifier)</b>	Open to Junior members of an affiliated Riding Club that have paid their membership for the current year. <b>BD Points:</b> Unlimited Prelim Points, 0 points at Novice or above. Horses downgraded to zero points under BRC downgrading rules are eligible. Horses cannot have competed in elementary or above in the same competition year, BD or BRC. Riders must <b>not</b> have gained the following qualifications; FBHS, BHSI, BHSII (a), BRC Eq 4, BD Groups 1 – 6 (b), (c). Test: <b>Prelim 2 (2016)</b>
<b>Class 2/2A*</b> Junior Winter Dressage <b>Preliminary Section (Qualifier)</b>	Open to Junior members of an affiliated Riding Club that have paid their membership for the current year. <b>BD Points:</b> Unlimited Prelim Points, 0 points at Novice or above. Horses downgraded to zero points under BRC downgrading rules are eligible. Horses cannot have competed in elementary or above in the same competition year, BD or BRC. Riders must <b>not</b> have gained the following qualifications; FBHS, BHSI, BHSII (a), BRC Eq 4, BD Groups 1 – 6 (b), (c). Test: <b>Prelim 7 (2002)</b>
<b>Class 3/3A*</b> Junior Winter Dressage <b>Novice Section (Qualifier)</b>	Open to Junior members of an affiliated Riding Club that have paid their membership for the current year. <b>BD Points:</b> Unlimited Novice Points, Up to 35 Elementary Points and 0 points at Medium or above. Horses downgraded to 124 points under the BRC downgrading rules are eligible. Riders must <b>not</b> have gained the following qualifications; FBHS, BHSI, BD Groups 1-5 (b) Test: <b>Novice 24 (2010)</b>
<b>Class 4/4A*</b> Junior Winter Dressage <b>Novice Section (Qualifier)</b>	Open to Junior members of an affiliated Riding Club that have paid their membership for the current year. <b>BD Points:</b> Unlimited Novice Points, Up to 35 Elementary Points and 0 points at Medium or above. Horses downgraded to 124 points under the BRC downgrading rules are eligible. Riders must <b>not</b> have gained the following qualifications; FBHS, BHSI, BD Groups 1-5 (b) Test: <b>Novice 27 (2007)</b>

- (a) Qualification not to have been gained within the past ten years
- (b) Refers to active members of BD during the last 3 years calendar years
- (c) Riders who have competed under FEI Rules in the relevant discipline in the last 5 calendar years

### ELIGIBILITY

Those with borrowed horses should check eligibility on points and winnings.

**In the Novice team competitions, 1 rider of each team will ride each test, i.e. 1 will ride BD Prelim 2 (2016), 1 will ride BD Prelim 7 (2002) 1 will ride BD Novice 24 (2010) and 1 will ride BD Novice 27 (2007). The best 3 scores to count.**

**Classes 1A/2A/3A and 4A are AREA competitions only.**

There will be full catering facilities serving hot and cold food throughout the day from the college cafeteria. HADRC will also be running an unaffiliated competition following this qualifier

### **Tack and Dress Rules**

Please make sure you adhere to tack and dress rules in the current version of the BRC rules. The full 2018 Rulebook is available to download online. If you have a query on the rules, please ring BRC on 02476 840593.

All hats must have a visible BRC hat tag in place before they are used for warming up and competing, to show that it meets the current safety standards. There will be a trained official available on the day to do this for you if your hat does not currently have one.

### **Equine influenza**

Your horse must have up to date influenza vaccinations in line with rule G7 in the current BRC Rulebook. There is also a checking device on the BRC website, but if you are unsure, please call BRC on 02476 840518.

### **Objections and queries**

Any queries should be addressed to the BRC Official Steward officiating at this event.

### **Health & Safety Policy**

The organisers have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must obey the instructions of the organisers and stewards, and avoid activities likely to cause accidents. Emergency services must have access to all parts of the showground and members of the public and their vehicles must not block access. Parents must assume full responsibility for their children's safety and control.

**RESERVATION:** the organisers reserve the right to cancel any class if deemed necessary and to refuse an entry without having to state the reason.

**COMPETITOR NUMBERS:** Must be worn at all times. Bridle/Saddle Pad Numbers may be worn, but must be shown on both sides of the horse.

### **SPECIAL NOTICES:**

- Lunging is not permitted.
- Please do not muck out lorries or trailers onto the car park.
- No horses or ponies must be left tied unattended to lorries or trailers.
- Please observe and respect all signs displayed by Easton & Otley College or HDRC.

Dressage and Riding Test competitions **Horses may be ridden in more than one test if being competed individually and / or as part of a team provided that each test is different and only one test is as part of a team.**

**Horses may compete in both Winter Novice and Intermediate Dressage Competitions.**

## **Entry Fees:**

**All entrants must pay a Prelim entry of £29 per team or £9.50 per individual to British Riding Clubs at least 21 days before the date of the qualifier.**

Please note only one competitor per test will qualify when using more than one arena appendix 11 in the rulebook will be applied to resolve the qualifying place. Entry forms can be found on the BRC website. Online entries via <https://brc.bhs.org.uk> Late prelim entries may be accepted at the discretion of the organiser with a late surcharge of £20 per team, if there are sufficient spaces. Late entries cannot be guaranteed therefore must not be paid for until approval from the organiser has been sought.

*If the date of the qualifier is cancelled for any reason, the close of prelim entry will remain. However, if the qualifier is moved more than 21 days later, entries will be re-opened but late entry fees cannot be refunded. Eligibility will be approved at the original close of prelim entry.*

**Individual entry fees, if not part of a team £12.50 per test.**

**First Aid £3 if not already included within a team**
