**HEALTH & SAFETY POLICY** The Organisers have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health & safety of everyone present at this event. ## **BRC HAT STANDARDS & DRESS RULES**

Please make sure you adhere to tack & dress rules in the current 2018 version of the BRC Handbook. Riding hats to worn when mounted & must have a visible aqua BRC hat tag in place before they are used for warming up and competing, to show that it meets the current safety standards. There will be a trained Official on the day to check for compliance with BRC hat standards & tag if your hat does not currently have one.

**COMPETITOR NUMBERS** Must be worn at all times. Bridle/Saddle Pad Numbers may be worn but Must be shown on both side of horse or pony.

## **EQUINE INFLUENZA**

Your horse must have up to date influenza vaccinations in line with rule G7 in the current BRC Rulebook. There is also a checking device on the BRC website, but if you are unsure, please call BRC on 02476 840518.

## **OBJECTIONS & QUERIES**

Should be addressed to the British Riding Clubs Official Steward officiating at this event. OBJECTIONS must be made in writing within 30 minutes of the incident or results being published with a £20.00 deposit, which will be forfeited if the objection is over-ruled. Judges/Official Steward reserve the right to cancel any classes if deemed necessary and refuse entries. The Judge's decision is final. The Owners/Organisers will not accept responsibility for any damage, loss, accidental injury or illness to horses, people or their property.

Horses may be ridden in more than one test if being competed individually and/or part of a team provided that each test is different and only one test is as part of a team.

## **ENTRY FEES**

**All qualifier class entrants must pay a Prelim entry of £29 per team or £9.50 per individual to British Riding Clubs at least 21 days before the date of the qualifier.**

Teams entering the Qualifier will automatically be entered into the Area Trophy Phase classes respectively

*Please note only one competitor per test will qualify when using more than one arena. Appendix 11 in the rulebook will be applied to resolve the qualifying place.*

**Qualifier Team entry includes an Area Team entry.**

**Area Teams not qualifying are entered on the attached Area entry form as 1A etc.**

Late prelim entries may be accepted at the discretion of the organiser with a late surcharge of £20 per team, if there are sufficient spaces. Late entries cannot be guaranteed therefore must not be paid for until approval from the organiser has been sought.

If the date of the qualifier is cancelled for any reason, the close of prelim entry will remain. However, if the qualifier is moved more than 21 days later, entries will be re-opened but late entry fees cannot be refunded. Eligibility will be approved at the original close of prelim entry.
